




# ACTIVITY OF NON - FINANCIAL ENTERPRISES<sup>1</sup> FOR 2011 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

#### 1. Overview

According to preliminary data 309 892 non-financial enterprises have submitted their annual reports for 2011 at the National Statistical Institute, employing 1 913 087 persons, generating 34 363 Million BGN of value added and making 13 933 Million BGN costs for gross investment in tangible goods.

Figure 2. Structure of persons employed by economic sectors and years




Figure 3. Structure of production value by economic sectors and years









Figure 4. Structure of costs for gross investment in tangible goods by economic sectors and years



#### 2. Industry

Annual reports on their activities in 2011 were submitted by 33 009 industrial enterprises, which were 10.7% of the total number of reported at the NSI.

By preliminary data in 2011 the value added at factor cost in the Industry reached 13 950 Million BGN at current prices. Compared to 2010, in the structure by activities, the share of section 'Mining and quarrying' increased by 1.7 percentage points and 'Manufacturing industry' - by 0.4 percentage points, reaching 11.3% and 64.9% respectively. The share of section 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' decreased by 1.8 percentage points to 19.1% and the share of section 'Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities' fell by 0.3 percentage points.

In the Industry the number of persons employed in 2011 reached 631 296 and formed the largest share - 33.0% of the total employment in the non-financial enterprises.




Figure 6. Structure of persons employed in the industrial enterprises by years





#### 3. Construction


The number of the construction enterprises, which have submitted annual reports on their activities in 2011 was 19 518, or 6.3% of all reported enterprises at the NSI.

By preliminary data in 2011 the construction sector realised the value added at factor cost for 2 601 Million BGN at current prices. In comparison with the previous year its share decreased by 0.5 percentage points to 7.6% in the total volume of the value added of non-financial enterprises.

In 2011 the persons employed in the construction sector were 162 944, as their share of the total number was 8.5% or 1.0 percentage points less than 2010.

#### 4. Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles

The number of the trade enterprises, which have submitted the annual reports on their activities in 2011 at the NSI, was 137 874, or 44.4% of the total number.




According to preliminary data the value added at factor cost in section 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' in 2011 reached 6 782 Million BGN at current prices. Compared to 2010 the structure of the value added by activities changed, as the share of 'Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles' increased by 0.4 percentage points reaching 28.5% and also the share of 'Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - by 0.1 percentage points or 8.8%, at the expense of the decreasing share of 'Wholesale trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - by 0.5 percentage points.

In 2011 the persons employed in the trade sector were 518 847 as their share of total employment in the non-financial enterprises was 27.1%, decreasing by 0.3 percentage points compared to the previous year.

#### 5. Services


By preliminary data 119 491 enterprises in the service sector have submitted their annual reports for 2011 at the NSI - 38.6% of the total number, as their share increased by 0.9 percentage points compared to 2010.

In 2011, by preliminary data, the service sector generated value added at factor cost for 11 030 Million BGN at current prices. Compared to 2010, its share in the total value added of the non-financial enterprises decreased by 0.8 percentage points to 32.1%.

Figure 11. Structure of value added at factor cost in the service activities by years








The number of persons employed in the service sector in 2011 reached 600 000, or 31.4% of total employment in the non-financial enterprises, and their share increased by 1.0 percentage points compared to 2010.

#### Methodological notes

**Coverage** - the non-financial enterprises on Structural Business Statistics include all sections by NACE Rev. 2, with the exception of 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing', 'Financial and insurance activities', 'Public administration, education, human health and social work activities', 'Activities of membership organisations' and 'Activities of households', in compliance with the Regulation (EC) 295/2008 on SBS.

**Turnover** includes the value of all receipts from sales of goods, own products and services, and taxes on products (excise duty)

The production value includes the value of turnover, reduced by the balance sheet of assets sold (without own fixed assets). It also includes changes in stocks of products and work in progress, and the amount of incurred expenditure for the acquisition of assets by economic means.

Value added at factor cost includes the production value, reduced by the amount of excise duty and the cost of operating activities, without these of staff plus financing revenues.
