



CRIMES, ACCUSED PERSONS AND PERSONS CONVICTED IN 2012

In 2012 the trials ended with penalty inflicted cover *34 249 committed crimes* that were by 6.7% less in comparison with 2011. Prevalent rate of these crimes were committed in 2012 (15 275 or 44.6% of the total number of crimes, ended with sentence). 12 032 (35.1%) crimes were committed in 2011 and 6 942 (20.3%) in previews years.

In 2012, 44 660 persons were accused for crimes commitment, of which:

- The number of persons with effective sentence of conviction amounted to 21 204 (it presents 47.5% of the total number of accused persons);
- Conditionally sentenced were 16 792 persons or 37.6% of the total number of accused persons;
- 4 913 persons or 11.0% of the total number of accused persons were released from penalty
- 1 463 accused persons were acquitted (3.3%);
- The trials of 288 persons (0.6%) were suspended;

The number of *persons convicted with penalties came into force was 37 996*. Compared to 2011 a decrease of the number of persons convicted was observed by 7.4%.

The group of convicted persons aged 14 - 17 years presents 6.1% of the total number of convicted persons and amounts to $2\,312$. In comparison with 2011 a decrease by 15.8% was observed. Convicted persons aged 16 - 17 decreased by 16.6%, as well as aged 14 - 15 – by 13.9%.

In 2012 the rate of criminal activity¹ was 596 per 100 000 persons of average annual criminally responsible population (age of 14 and over) and it was more compared to 2011 (when the number was 638 persons).

Highest was the rate of criminal activity of age group from 18 to 24 years (1 586 convicted persons per 100 000 persons of the population of the same age group), followed by the group of 25 - 29 age (1 321), 30 - 39 (921) and 14 -17 years (912). Lowest was the rate of criminal activity of persons aged over 50 - 132 persons per 100 000 and 40 - 49 - 563 persons per 100 000 persons of the population of the same age group.

Among the convicted juvenile persons the highest was rate of criminal activity of the persons aged 17 years (1 415 persons per 100 000 persons of the total population of that age group). For persons convicted aged

16 that coefficient was 974, for 15 years old persons - 792 and 14 years - 384 per 100 000 of the population belonging to the respective age group.

Generally dangerous crimes

The crimes of general danger (such committed in a way presenting a general danger or by means of general danger at the transport and communication, directed against public health or environment, related to the usage of nuclear energy for peace purposes, and other crimes of general danger) hold the first place as a number and relative share in the total of punished criminality. In 2012, 11 983 crimes of this kind have been punished, that presents 35.0% of the total crimes ended with penalties. The number of persons convicted for commitment of that type of crimes was 11 605 or 30.5% of the total number of convicted persons. In comparison with 2011 a decrease was observed by 9.9% of crimes and 10.3% of persons convicted for that type of crimes.

- Punished crimes against the transport and communications were 9 516 that presents 79.4% of the total number of generally dangerous crimes. The number of persons convicted for that kind of crimes was 9 330. In comparison with 2011 a decrease was observed by 12.4% and 12.3% respectively.
- In 2012 punished cases for "Theft of motor vehicle" decreased by 8.1% (from 211 in 2011 to 194 in 2012). A decrease was observed in the number of persons convicted for that type of crimes by 22.4%.
- In 2012 the number of punished drug-related crimes (contraband of drugs, production, processing, possessing, dissemination, transportation, carrying and other) increased in a small degree by 1.4% from 1 512 in 2011 to 1 533, as well as persons convicted for that type of crimes a decrease was observed by 0.3% (from 1 432 in 2011 to 1 427 in 2012).

Crimes against the property

The number of punished crimes against the property in 2012 was 11 679 or 34.1% of the total number of crimes with penalty inflicted. They include theft and robbery of property, misappropriation, fraud, extortion, receiving stolen goods, destroying and damaging of property. In comparison with 2011 the number of crimes with penalty inflicted decreased by 12.0%. Persons convicted for that type of crimes were 15 728 as in comparison with 2011 a decrease by 12.1% was observed.

• Thefts of property were most populated crimes among the punished crimes against the property. Their relative share was 75.4% from the crimes against property (76.6% in 2011) and 25.7% from





the total number of crimes with penalties inflicted. 8 801 crimes of that kind were concluded with penalty and 12 616 persons were convicted. that presents 16.6 and 20.8% more than previous year.

- 1 169 persons were convicted for commitment of 936 robberies (in 2011 their number was 1 325 and 1 050 respectively).
- 648 crimes were ended with penalties for committed frauds as the number of persons convicted for that type of crimes was 680. In comparison with 2011 an increase was observed by 3.0% and 1.3% respectively.

Crimes against the person

Punished crimes against person (homicide, assault and battery, discrediting, kidnapping and illegal constraint, compulsion, disclosure of a secret of another, insult and libel, debauchery, rape and traffic of people) amounted to 2 053 in 2012. It presents 6.0% of the total number of crimes with penalty inflicted. 1 935 persons were convicted for commitment of this kind of crimes. A decrease was observed by 3.2% and 1.6% respectively in the number of crimes and persons convicted.

- Among the crimes against the person highest was the number and relative share of bodily harms. The number of crimes ended with penalties inflicted for commitment of that type of crimes was 943 (45.9% of the total number of crimes against the person). For that type of crimes 969 persons were convicted, or by 2.6% less in comparison with 2011.
- 140 persons were convicted for commitment of 136 homicides (committed and attempted). In comparison with 2011 a decrease by 5.4% and 4.2% was observed respectively.
- The number of persons convicted for rape (committed and attempted) amounted to 99 persons for 98 committed and attempted rapes. In comparison with 2011 an increase by 13.8% of the number of persons convicted was observed as decrease of the number of crimes ended with penalties inflicted was 14.0%.

Crimes against the economy

An increase was observed in 2012 in comparison with 2011 by 6.4% of the number of crimes with penalty inflicted against the economy as well as of the number of persons convicted for that type of crimes – from 2 987 in 2011 to 3 155 in the reporting year that presents growth by 5.6%.

- The highest number and relative share were crimes related to selling and keeping of excisable goods without excise label. That type of crimes presents 43.4% of crimes ended with penalties against the economy. With penalties ended 1 368 crimes of that kind as persons convicted were 1 426. In comparison with 2011 a decrease by 11.1% and 12.3% was observed respectively.
- In comparison with 2011 an increase by 42.7% of crimes with penalties inflicted against custom's regime was observed. In 2012, 236 persons were convicted for that kind of crimes commitment that presents 44.8% more compared to preview year.

Other types of crimes

In comparison with 2011 an increase was observed in 2011 of:


- crimes with penalty inflicted against the financial, tax and insurance systems by 50.4%;
- crimes against the marriage, family and youth by 20.9%;
- crimes against the activity of state bodies, public organizations and persons performing public duties by 7.0%;
- Documentary crimes with penalty inflicted by 1.6%;

The number of persons convicted for these types of crimes commitment increased by 34.9, 24.3, 6.8 and 5.3% respectively.

Persons convicted by sex

The number of convicted males was 35 154 in 2012 that presents 92.5% of the total number of convicted persons. The number of convicted females was 2 842 in 2012 (7.5% of the total number of convicted persons). The coefficient of criminal activity of convicted males was 1 142 per 100 000 persons of respective population as well as for females it was 86 per 100 000 persons.

The highest number and relative share were females aged 30 - 39 years (798 persons or 28.1% of the total number of convicted females), and females aged between 40 - 49 years (524 persons, or 18.4%).

Persons convicted by age


The distribution of convicted persons by age in 2012 was:

- The highest was the share of persons aged 30 39 years 9 839 (25.9% of the total number of convicted persons);
- 18 24 years 9 818 persons (25.8%);
- Persons convicted aged 25 29 were 6 470 (17.0%);
- 40 49 years were 5 663 (14.9%);
- Aged 50 and over 3 894 persons (10.3%);
- The smallest in the structure of convicted persons by age is the share of age group 14 17 years -2312 persons (6.1%).

Persons convicted by penalty imposed


Persons convicted to imprisonment in 2012 were 25 146 (66.2% of the total number of convicted persons). The highest is the share of persons convicted for imprisonment up to 6 months - 11 903 persons (47.3%), followed by imprisonment from 6 months to 1 year - 7 361 persons (29.3%). Penalty of "Life imprisonment" was imposed to 6 persons.

Penalty of probation was imposed to 11 118 persons (29.3% of the total number of convicted persons). Penalty of fine was imposed to 1 288 persons, or 3.4% of the total number of convicted persons.

Methodological notes

Statistical data on crimes with penalties inflicted and persons convicted are obtained on the basis of annual data, received from the regional, district and military courts.

The survey object is the activity of the regional and district courts on penal trials of general, private and administrative character. Since 1998 the information for the activity of military courts is also included and since 2012 —of the Special Criminal Court. The information about the activity of Supreme Court of Cassation is not included.

Surveyed units are crimes, concluded with penalty inflicted and persons convicted with sentences come into force.

The numbers of crimes and persons convicted for certain reference year include those with sentence that has come into force during the same year.

The number of accused persons covers: convicted persons, conditionally convicted, discharged persons with proceedings finished suspension and persons with proceedings released from penalty.

Persons convicted with all kinds of inflicted penalty, including conditionally sentenced persons are included in the total number of persons convicted.

All crimes with penalties inflicted regardless they had been committed by one or more persons are included in the number of crimes concluded with penalty inflicted.

The age of persons convicted is given in completed years. Persons who have completed 14, but not 18 years are considered juveniles.

Convicted juvenile persons are included in the total number of persons convicted.

According to Chapter Three, Art. 31, Para. (1) and (2) of the Penal Code criminally responsible is the person of age - who has accomplished 18 years of age, who in a state of sanity commits a crime. A juvenile who has accomplished 14 years of age but who has not accomplished 18 years of age shall be criminally responsible if he could have realized the quality and the importance of the act and handle his conduct.

The criminal activity rate is calculated as correlation between the number of persons convicted and average annual number of the criminally responsible population (age of 14 and over).

Data on crimes with penalties inflicted and persons convicted are obtained on the basis of the NSI's statistical survey data and data from administrative source (Prosecutor's Office of the Republic of Bulgaria - National Investigative Services).
