




BULGARIAN TRADE WITH EU IN THE PERIOD JANUARY - APRIL 2016 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

In the period **January - April 2016** Bulgarian **exports to the EU** grew by 3.3% in comparison with the same period of 2015 and amounted to 9 595.2 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1 and 2). Main trade partners of Bulgaria were Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece, France and the Netherlands which accounted for 69.3% of the exports to the EU Member States (Annex, Table 3).

In **April 2016** the exports to the EU increased by 5.5% compared to the corresponding month of the previous year and added up to 2 535.3 Million BGN.

In the period **January - April 2016** in comparison with the same period of 2015 the largest growths in the exports of Bulgaria to the EU distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** (Annex, Table 4) were recorded in the sections 'Chemical and related products n.e.c.' (28.9%) and 'Food and live animals (23.1%). The most notable fall was recorded in section 'Mineral fuel, lubricants and related materials' (38.1%).






Bulgarian **imports from the EU** in the period **January - April 2016** decreased by 1.3% compared to the same period of the previous year and reached 10 549.1 Million BGN at CIF prices (Annex, Tables 1 and 2). The largest amounts were reported for the goods imported from Germany, Italy, Romania, Greece and Hungary (Annex, Table 3).

In **April 2016** the Bulgarian imports from the EU Member States dropped by 6.0% in comparison with April 2015 and amounted to 2 695.4 Million BGN.

In the period **January - April 2016** compared to the corresponding period of 2015 the largest growth in imports from the EU distributed according to the **Standard International Trade Classification** was reported in the section 'Beverages and tobacco' (18.1%) while the most notable fall was observed in section 'Crude materials, inedible (except fuel)' (32.5%).

The **foreign trade balance** of Bulgaria (export FOB - import CIF) **with** the **EU** in the period January - April 2016 was negative and added up to 953.9 Million BGN (Annex, Table 1). At FOB/FOB prices (after elimination of transport and insurance costs on imports) the trade balance was also negative and amounted to 248.4 Million BGN.
