



HOUSEHOLD INCOME, EXPENDITURE AND CONSUMPTION DURING THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2011

Household Income

The average quarterly total income average per household member during the third quarter of 2011 is 978 Levs or by 5.0% less compared to the same quarter of 2010. The main part of this income (80.0%) is received from wages and salaries and pensions.


Wages and salaries continue to be the main source of household income. During the third quarter of 2011 it is 499 Levs per capita or by 6.7% more compared to the third quarter of 2010. The relative share of wages and salaries within the total income increases from 50.2% to 51.0% or by 0.8 percentage points (pp) more compared to the third quarter of 2010.

The second important source of household income is the pensions. The relative share of pensions within the total income decreases by 1.5% and becomes 29.0%. During the third quarter of 2011 it is 284 Levs per capita.

The income from entrepreneurship decreases during the third quarter of 2011 is 88 Levs per capita. The relative share within the total income increases by 2.0 pp and it is 9.0%.

The weight of other social incomes during the third quarter of 2011 is relatively insignificant in the total household income. During the period this income increases from 26 to 36 Levs per capita, the relative share increases by 1.0 pp and becomes 3.7%.

The relative share of monetary income into the total income during the third quarter of 2011 is similar in comparison with the same quarter of 2010 and it is 97.3%.



Household Expenditure

The total expenditure per household member during the third quarter of 2011 is 917 Levs and it increases by 8.6% in relation to the same quarter of 2010. Expenditure on food and housing has the greatest share in forming the total expenditure and constitute 49.4% of total expenditure.

The most significant part in the household budget is expenditure **on food and non-alcoholic beverages**. As absolute values the expenditure increases by 4.7% and it is 332 Levs average per household member during the third quarter of the year, represents 36.2% in total expenditure and decreases by 1.4 pp in comparison with the same quarter last year.

The expenditure on housing (**water, electricity, heating and furnishing**) for the compared quarters is almost the same and becomes 148 Levs per capita; the relative decreases by 2.0 pp and it is 16.1% in total expenditure.


The expenditure on **health** increases by 7.2% during the third quarter of 2011 in comparison with the third quarter of 2010 and becomes 47 Levs per capita, which represents 5.1% in the total expenditure.

The expenditure on **transport and communication** increases by 11.1%, it is 98 Levs per capita as absolute values during the third quarter of 2011, the relative share increases to 10.7%.

The expenditure on **alcoholic beverages and tobacco** is 43 Levs per capita during the third quarter of 2011, which relative share of the total expenditure is 4.7% or the same compared to the third quarter of 2010.

The expenditure on **clothing and footwear** increases by 9.6% and it is 25 Levs per capita during the third quarter of 2011, which represents 2.7% of the total expenditure.

Household Consumption

The consumption of main food products average per capita doesn't change during the third quarter of 2011 compared to the third quarter of 2010. The most visible is the increase in the consumption of fruit by 4.2 kg and becomes 20.5 kg and vegetables - by 2.4 kg or 32.1 kg average per household member.

Figure 3. Consumption of main food products average per household member during the third quarter of 2010 and 2011


