



BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS STARTED IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2012

In the second quarter of 2012, the municipal authorities have issued **building permits** for construction of 1 228 residential buildings with 3 557 dwellings and 472 081 sq. m gross building area, of 41 administrative buildings/offices with 22 838 sq. m gross building area and 1 288 other buildings with 552 242 sq. m gross building area. As compared to the previous quarter the building permits for residential buildings increased by 41.5%, their dwellings - by 83.0% and the gross building area - by 67.5%. Rising was observed in the number of administrative buildings by 17.1% and of other buildings - by 27.0%, as their gross building area also increased by 61.7% and 22.8% respectively.




Figure 2. Building permits issued for construction - gross building area by type of buildings and by quarter

As compared to the second quarter of 2011 the issued building permits for new residential buildings decreased by 6.9%, but their dwellings rose by 17.3%. The administrative buildings fell by 38.8% and the other buildings - by 6.3% (Figure 1). An increase in the gross building area was registered in the residential buildings by 8.9%, and in the other buildings - by 24.9%, while in the administrative buildings the gross building area dropped by 47.1% (Figure 2).

The highest number of building permits for new residential buildings has been issued in the following districts: Plovdiv - 179, Burgas - 177, Varna - 114, Sofia - 103 and Sofia (capital) - 89. Most dwellings are to be built in the districts: Burgas - 1 584, Varna - 466, Sofia (capital) - 268, Plovdiv - 252 and Blagoevgrad - 129 (Table 1).

In the second quarter of 2012 **began the construction** of 683 residential buildings with 2 105 dwellings and 251 701 sq. m gross building area, of 20 administrative buildings/offices with 5 708 sq. m gross building area and 579 other buildings with 269 870 sq. m gross building area. As compared to the previous quarter the number of started residential buildings increased by 78.8%, their dwellings - by 66.8% and the gross building area - by 56.0%. The started administrative buildings marked a rising by 17.6%, but their gross building area fell by 9.1%. The number of other buildings increased by 47.0% and their gross building area - by 4.6%.

As compared to the second quarter of 2011 the number of started new residential buildings decreased by 6.7% and their dwellings - by 1.0%. The administrative buildings fell by 44.4% and the other buildings - by 14.6%. A decrease in the gross building area was registered in the residential buildings by 8.0%, in the administrative buildings - by 72.8%, but in the other buildings the gross building area rose by 3.8%.

The highest number of the construction of new buildings were started in the following districts: Burgas - 106 residential buildings and 38 other buildings; Varna - 89 residential buildings and 57 other buildings; Sofia - 67 residential buildings and 37 other buildings; Plovdiv - 64 residential buildings and 44 other buildings; Sofia (capital) - 56 residential buildings and 22 other buildings (Table 2).





Methodological notes

The quarterly statistical survey of permits issued for construction collects information about building permits, issued by municipal authorities as well as for the started construction of new buildings according to their type and gross building area. This information may be used as an indicator of future construction activity of enterprises in the country.

Type of buildings is classified according to the Classification of types of construction (CC) and is divided into:

- •Residential buildings for which the useful floor area is mostly used for permanent residential habitation.
- •Non-residential buildings for various purposes, including:
- administrative offices and buildings for administrative work of departments and other organizations and associations (representative buildings banks, post offices, government department offices, conference and congress centers, low courts, municipalities);
- other buildings buildings used for different activities: production, trade, transport, education, cultural, sports, agriculture, health, recreation and facilities for short stay (hotels, motels, rest houses, huts and others).

Gross building area - a sum of all floors areas in external dimensions.

Figure 1. Building permits issued for construction of new buildings by type and by quarter


