




BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS STARTED IN THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2018

In the fourth quarter of 2018, the municipal authorities issued **building permits** for construction of 1 477 residential buildings with 11 682 dwellings and 1 457 570 sq. m gross building area, of 33 administrative buildings/offices with 224 417 sq. m gross building area and 1 319 other buildings with 780 957 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter the issued building permits for residential buildings decreased by 11.0%, but the number of their dwellings grew by 24.0% and the gross building area - by 24.2%. The number of issued building permits of administrative buildings also shown a drop by 10.8%, while their gross building area rose by 5.6%. Issued building permits of other buildings grew by 9.3% and their gross building area - by 10.3%.

Figure 1. Building permits issued for construction of new buildings by type and quarter








As compared to the fourth quarter of 2017 the issued building permits for new residential buildings increased by 14.0%, their dwellings - by 59.4% and the gross building area - by 61.1%. The issued building permits of administrative buildings rose by 10.0% and their gross building area - over six times. The number of issued building permits (Figure 1) for other buildings increased by 16.7% and their gross building area - by 13.0% (Figure 2).

The highest number of building permits for new residential buildings was issued in the following districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 328, Plovdiv - 211, Varna - 156, Burgas - 139 and Sofia - 104. Most dwellings are to be built in the districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 5 290, Varna - 1 923, Plovdiv - 1 263, Burgas - 1 113 and Stara Zagora - 616 (Annex, Table 1).





In the fourth quarter of 2018 **began the construction** of 935 residential buildings with 5 881 dwellings and 757 784 sq. m gross building area, of 11 administrative buildings/offices with 9 715 sq. m gross building area and of 624 other buildings with 586 459 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter the number of started residential buildings decreased by 9.9%, their dwellings - by 0.7%, but their gross building area rose by 13.5%. The number of started administrative buildings and their gross building area registered a drop by 62.1% and 88.1% respectively. The started other buildings fell by 2.2%, while their gross building area grew by 30.7%.





Figure 3. Started construction of new buildings by type and quarter

As compared to the fourth quarter of 2017 the started new residential buildings increased by 20.0%, their dwellings - by 39.5% and their gross building area - by 39.4%. The number of started administrative buildings fell by 31.3% and their gross building area - by 64.2%. The started other buildings rose by 9.5% (Figure 3) and their gross building area - by 29.0% (Figure 4).

The construction of the highest number of new buildings were started in the following districts: Plovdiv - 159 residential buildings and 84 other buildings; Sofia (stolitsa) - 151 residential buildings and 21 other buildings; Burgas - 99 residential buildings and 74 other buildings; Varna - 116 residential buildings, 3 administrative buildings and 31 other buildings; Sofia - 85 residential buildings and 41 other buildings (Annex, Table 2).





Methodological notes

The quarterly statistical survey of permits issued for construction collects information about building permits, issued by municipal authorities as well as for the started construction of new buildings according to their type and gross building area. This information may be used as an indicator of future construction activity of enterprises in the country.

Type of buildings is classified according to the Classification of types of construction (CC) and is divided into:

- Residential buildings for which the useful floor area is mostly used for permanent residential habitation.
- Non-residential buildings for various purposes, including:
- administrative offices and buildings for administrative work of departments and other organizations and associations (representative buildings banks, post offices, government department offices, conference and congress centres, low courts, municipalities);
- other buildings buildings used for different activities: production, trade, transport, education, cultural, sports, agriculture, health, recreation and facilities for short stay (hotels, motels, rest houses, huts and others).

Gross building area - a sum of all floors areas in external dimensions.
