

ACTIVITY OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS¹ IN MARCH 2023

In March 2023, 2 124 accommodation establishments - hotels, motels, camping sites, mountain chalets and other establishments for short-term accommodation with more than 10 bed-places, functioned in the country (Annex, Table 1) with 60.5 thousand rooms and 124.1 thousand bed-places in them. In comparison with March 2022, the total number of accommodation establishments (functioned during the period) increased by 23.7% and the bed-places in them - by 19.3%.

The total number of nights spent in all accommodation establishments in March 2023 was 1 027.6 thousand, or by 29.0% more in comparison with the same month of the previous year, as the greatest increase (by 38.3%) was observed in 1 and 2 stars accommodation establishments.

In March 2023, 77.2% of all nights spent by non-residents and 42.1% of all nights spent by Bulgarian residents were realized in 4 and 5 stars hotels. In 3 star accommodation establishments, were spent 16.4% of all nights by non-residents and 29.1% of all nights by Bulgarian residents, while in the rest of the accommodation establishments (with 1 and 2 stars), they were 6.4% and 28.8%, respectively.





Figure 1. Nights spent in accommodation establishments by categories and months

In March 2023, the number of arrivals in all accommodation establishments increased by 31.9% compared to the same month of 2022 and reached 453.1 thousand, as an increase for both non-residents - by 33.7% and Bulgarian residents - by 31.2% was reported. Bulgarian residents spent nights in accommodation establishments in March 2023 were 327.1 thousand and spent 2.1 nights on average. The arrivals of non-residents were 126.0 thousand, and had 2.8 nights on average, as 75.7% of them spent nights in hotels with 4 and 5 stars.





In March 2023, the total occupancy of the bed-places in accommodation establishments was 27.0% and increased by 1.9 percentage points compared to March 2022. The highest occupancy of the bed-places was in 4 and 5 stars accommodation establishments - 37.8%, followed by 3 star accommodation establishments - 25.3%, and with 1 and 2 stars - 16.3%.







Figure 3. Occupation of the bed-places in accommodation establishments by categories and months

The total revenues from nights spent in March 2023 reached 79.6 million BGN or by 53.1% more compared to March 2022. An increase in revenues for both Bulgarian residents - by 58.1% and non-residents - by 46.4% was reported.





Methodological notes

Since 2012, the statistical survey on **accommodation establishments** has been carried out monthly in compliance with the Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism and the Regulation 1051/2011 of the Commission implementing Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism, as regards the structure of the quality reports and the transmission of the data.

All categorized hotels, camping sites and other types of accommodation establishments with more than 10 bed-places in use during the reporting period are included in the observation.

The indicator **other accommodation establishments** includes holiday settlements, hostels, guest houses, bungalows, rest houses, mountain chalets, private rooms and flats and other establishments for short accommodation.

Available Bed Capacity is the maximum number of bed-places offered for each day of the reference month.

The **revenues from nights spent** in accommodation establishments include the sums paid by the guests, without the extra services.
