


# EMPLOYEES UNDER LABOUR CONTRACT AND GROSS AVERAGE WAGES AND SALARIES, THIRD QUARTER OF 2022

According to the preliminary data of the National Statistical Institute (NSI), at the end of September 2022, the **number of employees** under labour contract decreased by 32.0 thousand, or 1.4%, as compared to the end of June 2022 and reached 2.28 million. The highest decrease was observed in economic activities: 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 17.0%, 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' and 'Real estate activities' - by 2.2%. The highest increase of the number of employees was recorded in economic activities: 'Information and communication' - by 1.1% and 'Education' - by 1.0%.

In the structure of employees by economic activities, the biggest relative share of employees was in 'Manufacturing' - 20.5% and 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - 16.7%.

At the end of September 2022, as compared to September 2021, the number of employees under labour contract decreased by 5.3 thousand, or 0.2%. The highest decrease in absolute figures was observed in economic activities 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - 7.3 thousand, 'Manufacturing' - 7.1 thousand and 'Construction' - 5.0 thousand, and the highest increase was in 'Information and communication' - 6.8 thousand and in 'Administrative and support service activities' - 5.4 thousand. In percentages, the highest decrease at the end of September 2022, as compared to September 2021, was in economic activity 'Construction' - by 3.9%, 'Accommodation and food service activities' - by 2.6% and in 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' - by 2.4%, as the highest increase was reported in 'Real estate activities' - by 8.1% and in 'Information and communication' - by 6.1%.

The **average monthly wages and salaries** of the employees under labour contract in July were 1 750 BGN, in August - 1 693 BGN and in September 2022 - 1 787 BGN.




# Figure 1. Gross average wages and salaries by months



In the third quarter of 2022, in comparison with the second quarter of 2022, the average monthly wages and salaries increased by 0.8% and reached 1 743 BGN. The highest increase in wages and salaries was reported in 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 7.8%, 'Public administration and defence; compulsory social security' - by 7.3% and in 'Arts, entertainment and recreation' - by 6.1%. The highest decrease in wages and salaries was recorded in economic activity 'Financial and insurance activities' - by 7.5% and in 'Mining and quarrying' - by 7.3%.

Compared to the third quarter of 2021, the average monthly wages and salaries in the third quarter of 2022 rose by 14.7%. The highest growth rates were recorded in economic activities: 'Agriculture, forestry and fishing' - by 17.8%, and in 'Public administration and defence; compulsory social security' and 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' - by 17.3%.


The economic activities with the highest wages and salaries in the third quarter of 2022 were:

- 'Information and communication' 4 191 BGN;
- 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' 2 554 BGN;
- 'Financial and insurance activities' 2 533 BGN.

The lowest wages and salaries were recorded in:

- 'Accommodation and food service activities' 1 069 BGN;
- 'Other service activities' 1 184 BGN;
- 'Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities' 1 286 BGN.

In comparison with a year earlier, the average monthly wages and salaries in the public sector grew by 12.5%, while in the private sector - by 15.4%.

#### **Methodological notes**

The source of information is the Quarterly Survey on employees, hours worked, wages and salaries, and other expenditures paid by the employer. It is a sample survey and its main purpose is to make a study of the current state and dynamics of some main aspects of the labour market. The sample used for the survey is a stratified random sample without replacement. Stratification criteria used include: economic activity (NACE Rev. 2), size of the enterprise (according to the number of employees) and regional breakdown (28 districts, NUTS3).
