


HOUSEHOLD INCOME, EXPENDITURE AND CONSUMPTION DURING THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2021

Household Income

The **total income** average per household member during the third quarter of 2021 is 1 938 BGN and increases by 10.5% compared to the same quarter of 2020.

The highest relative share of income within the total income is this from wages and salaries (58.2%). The relative share of income from pensions is 28.7% and from self-employment - 5.4%. Compare to the third quarter of 2020 the relative share of income from wages and salaries increases by 3.0 percentage points (pp), income from self-employment decreases by 1.1 pp and income from pensions decreases by 0.9 pp.

The nominal income by source average per capita during the third quarter of 2021 compared to the third quarter of 2020 changes as follows:

- Income from **wages and salaries** increases from 969 BGN to 1129 BGN (by 16.5%);
- **Self-employment** income decreases from 114 to 105 BGN (by 7.8%);
- Income from **pensions** increases from 519 BGN to 557 BGN (by 7.3%);
- Income from **social benefits** decreases from 50 BGN to 40 BGN (by 20.7%).


The relative share of monetary income into the total income during the third quarter of 2021 is 99.1% and the share of income in kind is 0.9%.

Household Expenditure

The **total expenditure** average per household member during the third quarter of 2021 is 1 808 BGN and increases by 15.2% in comparison to the same quarter of 2020.

The greatest share in forming the total expenditure has expenditure on food and non-alcoholic beverages - 29.8% as well as expenditure on housing - 17.4%, taxes and social insurance contributions - 12.9% and transport and communication - 10.9%.

The relative share of food and non-alcoholic beverages decreases by 0.3 pp compared to the third quarter of 2020 and the relative share of housing - by 0.4 pp. The share of recreation, culture and education increases by 0.8 pp and the share of health - by 0.3 pp.

The expenditure by group average per capita changes as absolute values during the third quarter of 2021 compared to the same quarter of 2020 as follows:


- Expenditure on **food and non-alcoholic beverages** increases from 472 BGN to 539 BGN (by 14.2%);
- Expenditure on **alcoholic beverages and tobacco** increases from 64 BGN to 74 BGN (by 16.2%);
- Expenditure on **clothing and footwear** increases from 52 BGN to 62 BGN (by 18.8%);
- Expenditure on **housing (water, electricity, heating, furnishing and maintenance of the house)** increases from 279 BGN to 315 BGN (by 13.1%);
- Expenditure on **health** increases from 89 BGN to 106 BGN (by 19.9%);
- Expenditure on **transport and communication** increases from 178 BGN to 198 BGN (by 11.5%);
- Expenditure on **recreation, culture and education** increases from 92 BGN to 121 BGN (by 30.4%);
- Expenditure on **taxes and social insurance contributions** increases from 214 BGN to 234 BGN (by 9.0%).

Household Consumption

The consumption of main food products average per household member during the third quarter of 2021 compared to the same quarter of 2020 changes as follows:

- Consumption increases most significant by: fruit - from 18.7 to 20.1 kg, meat - from 8.5 to 9.1 kg, meat products - from 3.1 to 3.7 kg, potatoes - from 6.6 to 7.0 kg, milk - from 4.4 litres to 4.6 litres, eggs - from 37 to 39 numbers;
- Consumption of bread and paste products decreases from 19.9 kg to 19.0 kg, yoghurt - from 7.7 to 7.3 kg.

Methodological notes

The source of data is the quarterly household budget survey. It is sample survey. The sample used for the survey is a random sample of 3 060 households.

A regular household represents two or more persons who live in one dwelling or part of a dwelling, having their meals together and having a common budget irrespective of the fact whether they are relatives. A household is also one person living alone, having meals separately and having his/her separate budget. Institutional households are not studied by the household budgets survey.

The main indicators for income, expenditure and consumption are estimated quarterly and annual as average values and relative share.

Household income in cash and kind includes all receipts of household members from: wages and salaries, pensions, entrepreneurship, unemployment benefits, social benefits, etc. Other regular or irregular transfers from other households and property sales are also included.

Household expenditure includes expenditure for food, beverages, tobacco, housing (water, electricity, heating, furnishing and maintenance), transport, communications, health, taxes, social insurance contributions, etc.

Consumption average per household member includes the quantities of foods and beverages consumed at home. The catering data are not included.
