REGISTRATIONS AND BANKRUPTCIES OF LEGAL ENTITIES

Quarterly data on registrations and bankruptcies

In the third quarter of 2023, the newly registered legal entities in the country are 9 829, and those declared bankrupt - 829. Compared to the same quarter of 2022, the total number of newly registered decreased by 6.5%, and that of bankrupts - by 25.8%.

Figure 1. Number of registrations and bankruptcies of legal entities in the third quarter of 2022 and 2023






Figure 2. Number of registrations and bankruptcies of legal entities in the third quarter in the period 2019 - 2023



Compared to the second quarter of 2023, newly registered legal entities decreased by 10.8%, and those that declared bankruptcy - by 15.8%.

Distribution of newly registered and bankrupt legal entities by sector

The distribution by economic sectors shows that the relative share of newly registered legal entities is the largest in sector G 'Trade; car and motorcycle repair' - 88.1% of all newly registered units in the third quarter of 2023. Among the companies declared bankrupt, the largest number again fall into sector G 'Trade; repair of cars and motorcycles' - 77.1% of the total number of bankrupt legal entities for the same period.

Methodological notes

The quarterly business demography of registrations and bankruptcies of legal (legal) entities is related to certain demographic events - date of establishment of the legal entity, date of declaration in bankruptcy proceedings, date of declaration of bankruptcy and date of declaration of liquidation. The data is presented in absolute values according to selected sections of the Classification of Economic Activities (NACE - 2008)1, according to the requirements of Regulation 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council of November 27, 2019, on European business statistics.

A legal unit is a legal entity under public or private law. This legal entity can be:

- A legal entity whose existence is recognized by law regardless of the persons or institutions that own it or are members;
- A natural person who, as an independent person, exercises economic activity. In order to
 exist, it must be legally registered with the competent administrative authorities
 (Commercial Register and Register of Non-Profit Legal Entities, Bulstat Register and
 others).
