

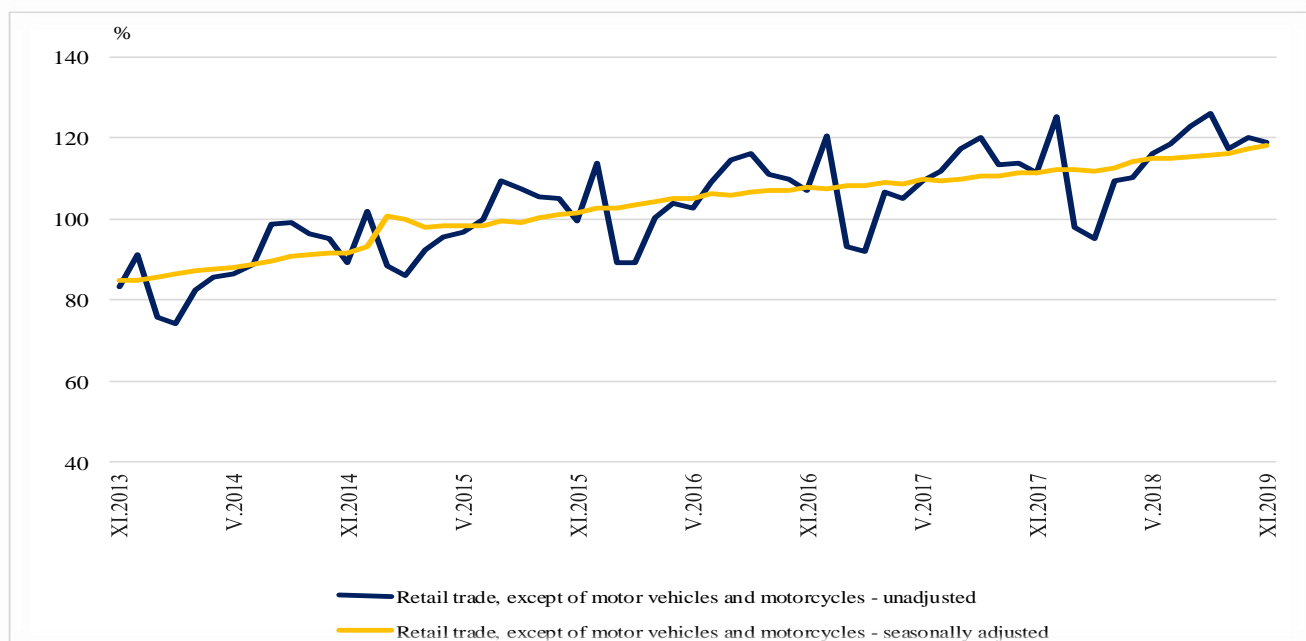


TURNOVER INDICES IN ‘RETAIL TRADE, EXCEPT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTORCYCLES’ IN NOVEMBER 2018^{1,2}

According to the preliminary seasonally adjusted data³ in November 2018 the turnover in ‘Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ at constant prices increased by 0.8% compared to the previous month.

In November 2018, the working day adjusted⁴ turnover in ‘Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles’ marked rise from 6.5% in comparison with the same month of the previous year.

¹ Data for November 2018 are preliminary.

² The monthly turnover indices reflect the short-term changes in the value of this indicator between two compared periods at constant prices. The information may be used to assess the current situation and the trends in the development of the trade sector as well as for short-term forecasts. In order to calculate the indices trade enterprises are observed by using a representative sample that forms about 70% of the annual receipts of the observed aggregate. The monthly turnover indices are calculated with 2015 as a base year.

³ Seasonal adjustment is a statistical method, which eliminates the seasonal component of time series.

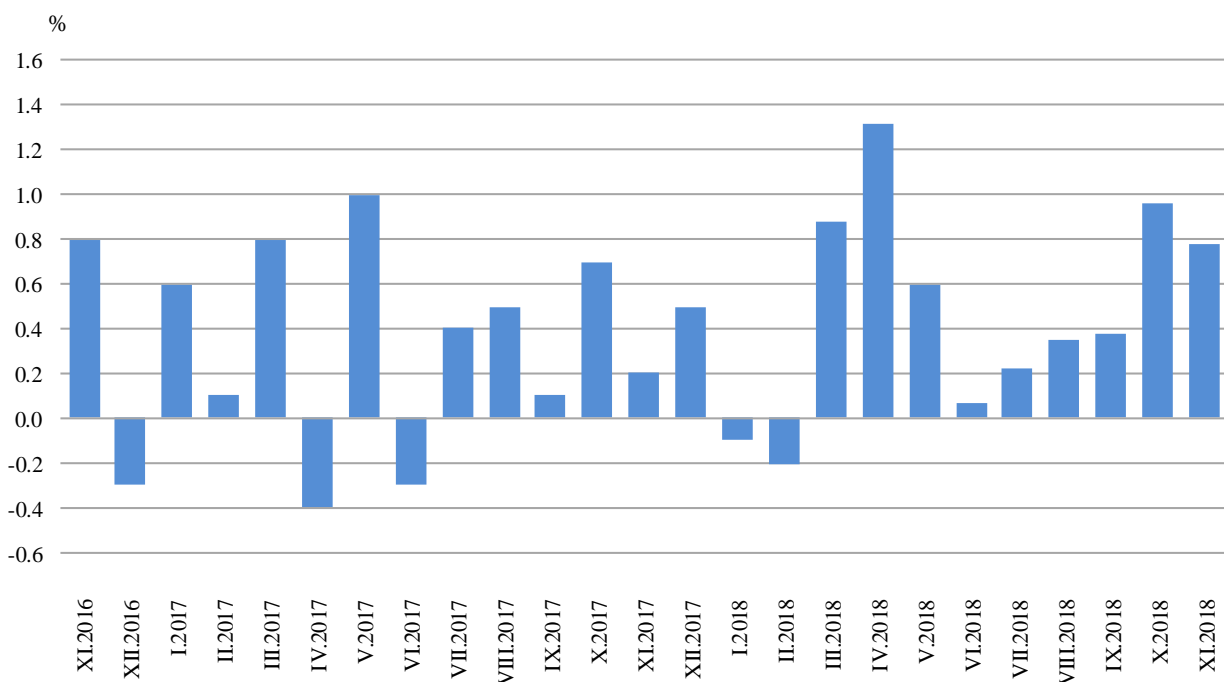
⁴ Working day adjustment is an adjustment for variations caused by calendar effects, different number of calendar and working days in the months, national holidays and outliers (for example the presence of more non-working days in May could contribute to the decline in the retail trade).



Monthly changes

In November 2018 compared to the previous month, more significant growth of turnover was observed in the 'Retail sale of textiles, clothing, footwear and leather goods' by 5.5%, in the 'Retail sale of automotive fuel' by 2.4% and in the 'Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco' by 1.1%. Decrease was noted in the 'Dispensing chemist; retail sale of medical and orthopaedic goods, cosmetic and toilet articles' - 1.0% and in the 'Retail sale of audio and video equipment; hardware, paints and glass; electrical household appliances' - 0.6%.

Figure 2. Change of turnover in 'Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles' compared to the previous month (Seasonally adjusted)

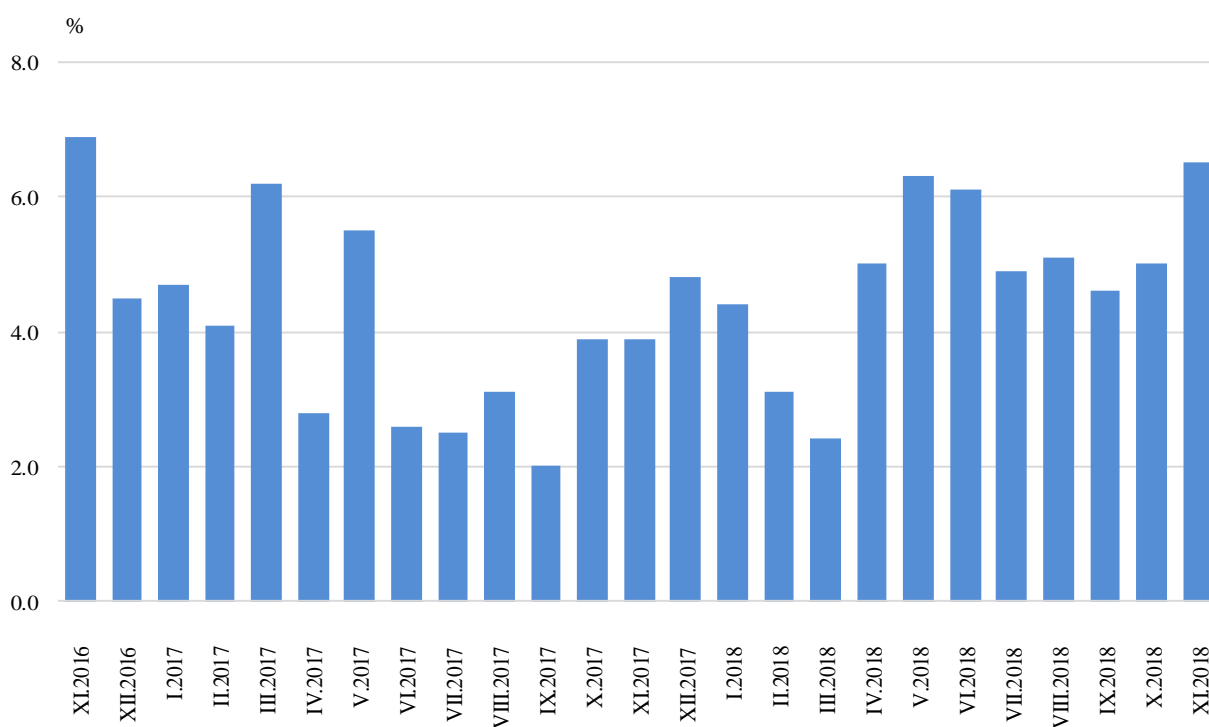




Annual changes

In November 2018 compared to the same month of 2017, **the turnover** increased more significantly in the ‘Retail sale via mail order houses or via Internet’ by 15.0%, in the ‘Dispensing chemist; retail sale of medical and orthopaedic goods, cosmetic and toilet articles’ by 14.9%, in the ‘Retail sale of textiles, clothing, footwear and leather goods’ and in the ‘Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco’ by 9.0%. Decline was registered in the ‘Retail sale of computers, peripheral units and software; telecommunications equipment’ - 5.4%
