TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN SEPTEMBER 2022

In September 2022, **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 643.7 thousand (Annex, Table 1) or by 11.1% above the registered in September 2021.




Figure 1. Trips of Bulgarian residents abroad by months






Figure 2. Top foreign destinations for Bulgarian residents by purpose of visit in September 2022

In September 2022 most trips of Bulgarian residents were made to: Turkey - 169.0 thousand, Greece - 163.4 thousand, Germany - 52.1 thousand, Serbia - 48.5 thousand, Romania - 48.1 thousand, Republic of North Macedonia - 24.3 thousand, Italy - 19.7 thousand, Austria - 16.1 thousand, the United Kingdom - 14.8 thousand, Czechia - 12.9 thousand (Figure 2).

The trips with holiday and recreation purpose in September 2022 composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 42.3%, followed by those with other purposes (as a guest, education and visit the cultural and sports events) - 39.3%, and with professional purpose - 18.4%.




Figure 4. Arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria by months

In September 2022, **the number of visits of non-residents to Bulgaria** was 1 112.7 thousand (Annex, Table 2) or 44.0% more in comparison with September 2021 (Figure 4). An increase in the trips with all observed purposes was registered. Transit passes through the country were 35.9% (399.2 thousand) of all visits of non-residents to Bulgaria.


The share of visits of EU citizens was 49.2% of the total number of non-residents' visits to Bulgaria in September 2022 and reached 547.0 thousand, the largest being by visitors from Romania - 32.2%, Germany - 16.3% and Greece - 14.3%.

The visits of non-residents in the group 'Other European countries' were 445.6 thousand, or 40.1% of all visits to Bulgaria. The highest number of visits from Turkey - 186.3 thousand or 41.8% in this group was registered.


In September 2022 the most visits to Bulgaria were from: Turkey - 186.3 thousand, Romania - 175.9 thousand, Ukraine - 98.0 thousand, Germany - 89.2 thousand, Greece - 78.4 thousand, Poland - 67.7 thousand, Serbia - 60.8 thousand, the United Kingdom - 47.6 thousand, Republic of North Makedonia - 37.0 thousand, Czechia - 22.0 thousand.

In September 2022, the predominant share of the visits was with other purposes - 47.4%, followed by trips with holiday and recreation purpose - 40.4%, and with professional purpose - 12.2%.

Methodological notes

The definitions recommended by the World Tourist Organization and the Methodological manual for tourism by Eurostat are applied by the National Statistical Institute.

In accordance with these definitions **an international tourist** is any person who travels to a country other than his/her permanent residence for less than a year and whose main purpose is not doing any activity for payment in place visited.

The purposes of visiting a country are the following:

- Excursion, holiday or entertainment (visits to cultural or historical landmarks, sport events and others);
- Visiting friends and relatives;
- Professional purposes (business trips, participation in conferences, congresses, concluding deals, etc.);
- Other (education, medical treatment, etc.) purposes.

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian residents travelling abroad and visits by non-residents to Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and a sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among residents and non-residents passing through border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens from 'third countries' are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are obtained on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing residents and non-residents through the border check points.
